### II. MATERIAL USED

- Fecus racemosa barks
- Azadirachta indica leaves
- Citrus limon fruit (lemon)
- Rose water
- Aloe barbadensis miller gel
- > Honey
- Distilled water
- Round bottom flask (RBF)
- ➢ Beaker
- ➢ Measuring cylinder
- ➢ Weighing balance
- ➢ Filter paper
- Tripot stand
- Conical flask
- Water bath

#### III. EXPERIMENTAL METHODOLOGY

- Take a clean 100 ml round bottom flask (RBF) and 80 ml distilled water to it.
- Weigh accurately 50 gram of fecus racemosa barks and grind it well.
- Add this grinded barks to RBF.
- Now take another RBF and add 50ml of distilled water to it.
- > Add accurately 5 gram of Neem leaves to this RBF.
- Allow both the RBF to boiling for 30 min in water bath.
- After 30 min allow them to cool.
- > Filter both the products separately by filter paper.
- ▶ Now mix both the filtered products.
- Take 70ml of this product in a beaker and add 10ml of Aloe Vera gel to it.
- Add 5 ml honey and 2 ml lemon juice as a preservative.
- Mix it uniformly and make up the volume upto 100 ml by rose water.
- Store it in tightly packed container.
- > The product (Herbal Skin Lotion) is ready for use.

## IV. DISCUSSION

This product is 100% herbal based and hence does not have any risk of side-effects. It is easy to use having more effectiveness than the chemical lotions.

#### V. CONCLUSION

This product have healing and moisturizing property so can be useful for dry skin. It have capacity to fight against acne and pimples which is the major skin disorder. It also have anti-aging, astringent, disinfectant, antiinflammatory and Skin softening properties. It also have ability to remove black heads.

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
